ISE Scholarship for Foreign Students of International Admission 2026

ISE scholarship for foreign students aims to support eligible applicants of non-Thai nationality with excellent academic performance and have completed the application of the Bachelor of Engineering (International Program), Faculty of Engineering for the academic year 2026 of International Admission. The details of the scholarship and requirements are as follows:

1. Types of scholarship

1.1 Full Scholarship covers the following for 4 years.

- 1) Tuition fees
- 2) Program fees
- 3) Economy class round trip ticket from home country to Bangkok
(applicable to applicants who live abroad)
- 4) Monthly stipend and accommodation
- 5) Health insurance

1.2 Tuition Scholarship covers the following for 4 years.

- 1) Tuition fee and program fees
- 2) Health insurance

2. Eligibility Requirements

2.1. Must not be over 25 years old and must be non-Thai nationality.

2.2 Have completed or expected to complete high school or passed an equivalent high school standard test

2.3 Must be in good health

2.4 Must complete the application of the Bachelor of Engineering (International Program), Faculty of Engineering for the academic year 2026 (International Admissions) <http://www.ise.eng.chula.ac.th/> and pass the admission requirements of **either option 1 test score or option 2 portfolio** as mentioned in the announcement of International Admission 2026.

2.5. Admitted applicants to the Bachelor of Engineering (International Program) for the Academic Year 2026 (International Admission) will be eligible to be considered for a scholarship from International School of Engineering according to the Announcement of ISE Scholarship for Foreign Students of International Admission 2026.

3. Scholarship Application Period

There are two rounds of application as follows;

First round application: December 22, 2025–February 6, 2026

Second round application: March 20–May 1, 2026

The applicants must indicate the intention of the scholarship application in the application of the Bachelor of Engineering (International Program), Faculty of Engineering for the academic year 2026 (International Admission) and agree the conditions of the ISE scholarship for foreign students.

4. Scholarship Assessment

The assessment of the scholarship applicants will be ranked based on the admission requirements and the offer made to the applicants who best meet the selection criteria by the scholarship committee.

5. Requirement to maintain scholarship

During the scholarship term, the recipient must maintain GPAX at least 3.00 and support the promotion of the ISE programs at least 80 hours per semester assigned by the ISE Office.

6. Terms and condition of the scholarship

During the scholarship terms, the recipient must maintain GPAX at least 3.00 and support the promotion of the ISE programs as assigned by the ISE Office. ISE reserves the right to suspend or terminate the scholarship for the following reasons.

- 6.1 The recipient is deemed to be seriously ill and not physically fit to carry on study
- 6.2 The recipient obtains GPAX of less than 3.00
- 6.3 The recipient is absent during the semester without notice or reasonable explanation.
- 6.4 The recipient violates the law, or the rules, regulation, announcement or orders issued by the University, or Faculty of Engineering.
- 6.5 The recipient fails or does not complete the assigned work as specified by ISE.
- 6.6 The recipient does not reside in Thailand during the scholarship period, with the following two exceptions:
 - 6.1.1 During the semester, the recipient must inform ISE of the departure with endorsement from the advisor. The advisor shall assure that the absence will not interrupt the study. Once the request is approved, the recipient can depart. In this regard, ISE will not be responsible for the airfare. If the recipient's absence exceeds 10 days, the recipient will not be entitled to the allowance for the month(s) of absence.

6.1.2 During the vacation period, the recipient must inform ISE of the departure with endorsement from the advisor. The period of absence must not exceed 1 month. Once the request is approved, the recipient can depart. In this regard, ISE will not be responsible for the airfare. If the recipient's absence exceeds 1 month, the recipient will not be entitled to the allowance for the month(s) of absence. Additionally, the recipient must submit the endorsed leave of absence request form to ISE at least 3 days in advance. Upon return, the recipient must submit a photocopy of the entry passport to ISE within 3 days.

7. Supporting document

The applicants must provide certificate of health examination from hospital to support the scholarship application.

8. Notification of decision

The announcement of scholarship awardees will be made by **March 4, 2026** for the first-round admission and by **May 20, 2026** for the second-round admission and the committee's decisions will be final without any right to appeal.
