



AERCAP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

AerCap is the industry leader across all areas of aviation leasing – aircraft, engines and helicopters. AerCap has a highly attractive portfolio, a diversified customer base and an order book of the most indemand new technology assets in the world.

AerCap is committed to supporting the next generation of industry professionals through educational programs such as the Aerospace Engineering program at Chulalongkorn. These programs provide a pipeline of diverse talent that will support the future growth and development of the aviation industry.

AerCap will award scholarships to 10 Aerospace Engineering students, commencing in academic year 2024.

- Three scholarships to first-year students of academic year 2024, covering four academic years.
- Three scholarships to second-year students of academic year 2024, covering three academic years.
- Four scholarships to third-year students of academic year 2024, covering two academic years.

The scholarship includes coverage of Chulalongkorn University tuition fees and program fees for regular semesters, and Industrial Training fees. Selected Third-year scholarship recipients will have the opportunity to participate in an internship program with AerCap. Additionally, Fourth-year scholarship recipients may engage in a research project in collaboration with AerCap, focusing on a research topic approved by AerCap.

Eligibility

- **2024–First–Year Scholarships**: Applicants must be first-year (Student ID 67xxx) full-time Thai students in the Aerospace Engineering Program.
- **2024–Second–Year Scholarships**: Applicants must be second-year (Student ID 66xxx) full-time Thai students in the Aerospace Engineering Program who have completed no less than 34 credits and have a GPAX above 3.00.
- 2024-Third-Year Scholarships: Applicants must be third-year (Student ID 65xxx) full-time Thai students in the Aerospace Engineering Program who have completed no less than 70 credits and have a GPAX above 3.00.

How to Apply

- Complete the AerCap Scholarship Application Form, which requires applicants to answer questions and upload the following documents:
 - 1. Your photo (showing your full face, taken within the last six months)
 - 2. Copy of academic transcript/certificate (showing the recent GPAX in a 4.00 system)
 - 3. Portfolio
 - 4. CV
 - 5. SOP (Maximum 1000 words, including motivation and future contribution to the aviation industry)
 - 6. Copy of national ID card
 - 7. Copy of student ID card (For Second-Year Scholarship and Third-Year Scholarship applicants only)
- Request one recommender to complete the **AerCap Scholarship Reference Form**. The recommender should then return the form directly to us. (Please note that the recommender cannot be a family member).

19 June 2024	Notification of successful candidates eligible for an Interview ^[1]
24 - 28 June 2024	Interview: Successful candidates interviewed by AerCap and Chula Engineering interviewer panel
5 July 2024	Announcement of Scholarship Recipients ^[2]
Successful candidates are selected based on the evaluation of application documents. Maximum of 20 candidates (6 first-year, 6 second-year, and 8 third-year students) proceed to the interview. Decisions of AerCap Scholarship selection team are final and absolute.

As an AerCap Scholarship holder, you must:

- 1. Maintain satisfactory academic progress.
- 2. Maintain good, ethical, and moral behaviour throughout their participation in the AerCap Scholarship program. This includes adherence to academic integrity standards, respectful treatment of peers and instructors, and compliance with all relevant institutional policies and codes of conduct.
- 3. Obtain permission from the AerCap Scholarship selection team before making any changes to your program of study, such as course transfers or leaves of absence.
- 4. Undertake a research project in collaboration with AerCap on an approved research topic, if requested.
- 5. Act as an ambassador by providing student profiles or testimonials, and by attending scholarship events, if requested.
- 6. Notify the scholarship selection team of any existing or newly awarded scholarships or sponsorships, as the scholarship may be adjusted or withdrawn if other sources of funding have been awarded.
- 7. Consent to AerCap and Chulalongkorn University contacting you after your graduation for an update on how the scholarship has impacted your career.
- 8. Repay a pro-rata amount of the scholarship if you withdraw from the Aerospace Engineering Program before completion.
