Q1. When can I apply / When is the admission period for International School of Engineering (ISE)?

December 20, 2021-February 4, 2022

Q2. How to apply to ISE (International Admission Round) Academic Year 2022?

- There are 2 application options.
 - Option 1 : Test Score
 - Option 2 : Portfolio

Students must choose <u>only one</u> option <u>either</u> Option 1 Test Score <u>or</u> Option 2 Portfolio

Q4. Is it possible to use GED or IGCSE to apply and what is the minimum requirement?

- Students can apply with GED / IGCSE, however students must request for Equivalency of Foreign Educational Qualifications with Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center.

Q5. My transcript was confirmed by my school principal, why clarification is needed?

- It is Chulalongkorn University requirements that before applying the undergraduate admission, students with GED, IGCSEs, studied abroad or having other international qualifications should contact Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center (https://hsces.atc.chula.ac.th) for Degree Equivalence Certificate.
- Applicants with international education systems need to request an actual Equivalence Certificate or Provisional Equivalence Certificate in order to apply for an international undergraduate program of Chulalongkorn University.
- Request for actual Equivalence Certificate For applicants with a foreign High School Diploma
- Request for Provisional Equivalence Certificate For applicants currently attending foreign high school and appropriately qualified for equivalence application
- Request for GPA Equivalency In case that applicant's high school does not use 4.0 grading system, applicants are required to convert a grade report to the 4.0 grading system with Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center.

Q6. Does the program accept credit transfer from another university?

- No, ISE still does not have a policy to accept credit transfer from other universities yet.
- Applicants must start applying the undergraduate admission the same as high school students.



Q7. I have only AS level grade, can I apply?

No, AS level is not accepted for ISE undergraduate admission.

Q8. Is there any English language preparatory courses for students whose English scores are below the minimum requirements?

- No, we do not have Pre-sessional English Course
- Applicants must meet the English proficiency score minimum requirement to be eligible for applying.

Q9. I am coming from an English speaking country, where my school was taught in English Language, will I still take a placement test in English Language?

- Students, who studied in school which classes are instructed in English for at least 2 academic year, need to provide official confirmation from the institution that English was used as the medium of instruction.
- The certificate of the English curriculum will be equivalent to passing score.



Q10. How many years to graduate?

• It takes 4 year to complete the Bachelor of Engineering at Chulalongkorn University.

Q11. How much is the tuition fee for this program for international student? How much is the total tuition and program fees for 4 years (8 semesters)?

Q12. Are there any scholarships for international students?

Yes, full scholarships and tuition fee scholarships are available. The assessment of the scholarship applicants will be ranked based on the admission requirements and the offer made to the applicants who best meet the selection criteria by the scholarship committee.



Q13. If I enroll as a student of the University, is it possible for me to work and study at the same time?

Legally, you can't do any kind of work on a student visa

Q14. How much is the cost of living?

Books:

Approximately 5,000 Baht/semester [~150\$]

Food and other expenses:

≥10,000 Baht/month

(apart from room rent, a meal on average is 50-100 Baht) [~300\$]

Dormitory:

≈15,000 Baht/month (including electricity and water rates) [~450\$]



Q15. Does ISE have on campus accommodation?

On campus

We have on-campus accommodations. CU iHouse is a residence for international students and lecturers. The residence is included in the university's shuttle bus services. https://www.chula.ac.th/en/academics/life-at-cu/accommodation/

Off campus

There are a number of apartments available close to the university. Rents can range from 8,000 - 15,000 baht per month, approx. 300 - 500 US\$ per month depending on amenities and location.
